

Sex, Drugs & Rock'n Roll in a (very) small country

PIPAPO - sex, drugs & rock'n roll

pipapo is an outreach project implemented in the cultural and in the festival scene in the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg.

Based on a peer approach, pipapo is present with several kind of interventions at the main festivals of the country and as well in the club scene. The interventions include harm reduction information on drug use and the distribution of earplugs, condoms, as well as a drug checking service called DUCK.

In this framework, a survey on recent drug use aims to characterize the Luxembourgish partygoers.

During 2016, PIPAPO was present at 11 events. 1823 visitors participated in our survey and 1806 questionnaires has been validated and analyzed as followed.




855 or 47.3% of the participants were male

951 or 52.7% of the participants were female

Median age is 22 years, ranging from 12 til 65 years.

Reported drugs consumed in the last two weeks by gender (%):

The results show that alcohol, tobacco and cannabis seem to be commonly used by a large portion of the participants. Interestingly, men report to consume more regularly than women. This difference appears to increase among the illicit drugs.
